FEEDING DIRECTIONS: Daily feeding requirements vary, depending on breed of rabbit, age, environmental conditions, and stage of production. Some general guidelines for feeding are:

Amount Fed/Day	
Small breeds	2 – 3 oz
Medium breeds	3.5 – 4 oz
Large breeds	5 – 8 oz

Growing rabbits and lactating will require more food per day, and should be full-fed. Other rabbits should be fed at the same time each day. No supplemental vitamins or minerals are necessary since Buckeye® Rabbit Feeds are nutritionally complete and balanced. Plenty of clean, fresh water should be provided at all times.
