Dairy Cows*

In Lactation Refer to the Buckeye® Dairy Pamphlet and Buckeye® Mineral Pamphlet to determine how to make up the grain ration, the amount of this grain ration to feed based on production, and the amount of additional 38% Dairy Concentrate to top-dress to high producing dairy cows. Normally 40 lb. of Buckeye® 17-17% is required per ton of grain mix (a corn and soybean meal mixture plus salt) when lactating animals are receiving forages made up of primarily legumes. If animals are not showing good heats, add ten more pounds per ton to the grain mix. If the animals do not exhibit a positive response after 30 days, contact your Buckeye® representative.

Dry Cows - Feed to dry cows at the rate of 4 ounces per head per day or hand feed in a self-feeder in the pasture or dry lot. Buckeye® Dry Cow Mineral, formulated specifically for dry cows in gestation is recommended where available. Follow the usage direction listed on the tag.

Heifers - Heifer grain rations should contain 50 pounds per ton of Buckeye® 17-17% Mineral when fed haylage or grass pasture and be fed the grain mix at a rate of 5 pounds per head per day. Another highly recommended premix mineral for growing dairy animals is Buckeye Bova Supreme Premix with 1440 g per ton of lasalocid.

Beef Cattle*

Hand feed at the rate of 3 oz per day to improve fertility and herd health.

***Selenium** Each pound of Buckeye® 17-17% Mineral contains 15.4 mg of Selenium per pound or .96 mg per ounce. The maximum legal amount of this product, providing there is no other Selenium source is:

Lactating Dairy Animals: Mineral or Salt mixtures containing Selenium are legally not allowed to be fed on a free choice basis. If low Magnesium in the forage is of concern Buckeye® Brood Cow Mineral should be made available to the breeding herd rather than Buckeye® 17-17 Mineral.
