- Mixes easily with warm water (110° F)
- Balanced trace minerals and vitamins to ensure optimum nutrition for strong growth including 100 IU per lb of Vitamin E.

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FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

Feed colostrum for the first three days to the newborn calf, switching to milk replacer on the fourth day. Mix ½ lb milk replacer (enclosed cup holds approximately 8 oz) in 2 quarts of warm water (110° F) using a clean bucket or nipple feeder. Feed 1 ½ to 2 quarts of this mix to light breed calves (Jerseys) or 2 to 2 ½ quarts to heavy breed calves (Holstein, Brown Swiss) twice a day. Keep the young calf in a dry, draft free environment with access to a clean, fresh supply of drinking water. Introduce the calf to, **Buckeye® 16% Calf Ration** or **Buckeye® Complete Calf Pellets** at seven days of age. Allow the calf access to excellent quality hay at four weeks of age. Begin weaning calves at 4 weeks of age by reducing either the amount of liquid milk replacer or the concentration of it. By 6-8 weeks of age the calves should be completely weaned. At weaning the calf should be eating at least 1.5 to 2 pounds of calf starter per day. After the calf is weaned continue feeding **Buckeye® Calf Starter** and excellent quality hay.
